- 5. Acceptance and Enrollment (or your written intent to enroll by September 2018) at an accredited four-year college or university.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- 1. Academic Accomplishments.
- 2. Citizenship, Community Service, and Extracurricular Activities.
- 3. Teacher and/or Counselor Recommendations.
- 4. One Written Essay (up to 500 words total/2 pages maximum) that covers both topics below.
 - A. What has taught you good sportsmanship?
 - B. How can you demonstrate to others the ability to combine dedication to both athletics and academics?
- 5. Interview with our Scholarship committee of all Finalists, if necessary.
