As you think about your idea or project, keep in mind the following criteria with which we will use to evaluate your proposal:

- Number of Students Impacted: a grant benefiting 10 students would not rate as highly as one benefiting 100.
- <u>Degree of impact on the Students</u>: The value and improvement offered over already available resources.
- **School Contribution**: Amount UCHS contributes to your team/club and annual cost to run program.
- <u>Longevity of the Project</u>: Items that last just one year would not rate as highly as materials that could be used over 5-10 years.
- **Practicality**: Measures whether the project is realistic and "do-able", or likely to suffer from problems like lack of training, difficulty of coordination, etc.
- Cost Effectiveness: The cost per pupil or the "bang for the buck."
- <u>Innovation</u>: Is your proposal a new or creative solution to a common problem? Are you thinking "outside the box?"
- <u>Collaboration</u>: The degree to which the grant involves or promotes collaboration and cooperation among different classes, grades or schools.

We look forward to reviewing your grant application. The grants will be submitted for final approval by the Foundation Board. Please email grants@uc-centurionfoundation.com if you have any questions about the grant process.
